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Discussion / Decision taken

Welcome Address by the Chair:

1. The Chair welcomed the members of the House present in the Meeting.
2. Due to the unavailability of all the external members, it is suggested by the Chair to arrange a meeting with all the internal and external members (preferably in online).

Agenda 1: Review of 17th IQAC meeting

A review of 17th IQAC meeting was done and approved by the house.

Agenda 2: Settlement of Vision, Mission, Long and Short Term goals of TINT

- 2.1 It is proposed by Prof. Ayan Chakraborty to modify the college vision keeping in view NEP 2020. The first college vision was settled in 2017.
- 2.2 A rough draft of the modified college vision is prepared by Prof. Ayan Chakraborty and Prof. Anwesha Datta Ain and presented before the house for suggestions/modifications. The finalized college vision will be sent to the academic council for ratification.
- 2.3 It is advised by Prof. R.T. Goswami, Prof. Milan Basu and Prof. Shiladitya Munshi to remove NEP 2020 and add the term “skill enhancement” in the new modified version of TINT vision. Further, addition of key terms like “collaboration with other institutions for research, societal benefits and industry” is advised by Prof. R.T. Goswami. Prof. Shiladitya Munshi suggested to define the institute output that are relatable to human and real world aspects.
- 2.4 The house agreed unanimously that TINT vision should focused on research, innovation, entrepreneurs and employment. Additionally, terms such as



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“sustainable social, economical and ecological growth” must be also given consideration.

2.5 It is suggested by Prof. R.T. Goswami to go through the institute mission of some premier institutes of national repute for modifying the TINT mission.

2.6 A rough draft of the modified institute mission is proposed by Prof. Ayan Chakraborty and Prof. Anwesha Datta Ain. It is suggested that proper ambience creation is essential in an institute for conducting optimal teaching learning activities. In this regard, the house suggested to include the keywords like “quality education, state-of-the-art research opportunities, rigorous course work, transformative education for academic and research improvement.

2.7 Prof. R.T. Goswami advised that the second mission may be included in the institute core values. Instead, the problems of the society, nation and world that can be solved by the students may be included.

2.8 Innovation and development should be the key highlights in the third mission of TINT. This will lead to collaboration with the outer world. A rough draft of the institute long term goals is proposed by Prof. Ayan Chakraborty and Prof. Anwesha Datta Ain. It is suggested by the house unanimously that autonomy in education through research and innovation for developing leaders generating employability should be the long term goal of TINT. Also, removal of keyword “centre of excellence” is suggested.

2.9 A rough draft of the institute short term goals is proposed by Prof. Ayan Chakraborty and Prof. Anwesha Datta Ain. Prof. Anwesha Datta Ain is requested to make the short term goals short keeping their inner meaning same. It is suggested by the house to address the remaining agenda after the finalization of Institute Vision, Mission, Long term and Short term goals.

2.10 Prof. Anwesha Datta Ain is requested to incorporate all the necessary changes and corrections by 24.5.22.

2.11 Due to shortage of time it is decided to address the remaining agenda on next meeting.

The next meeting is scheduled on 26.5.22 at 3:00 pm in the Board Room, TINT.
